Reentry refers to the transition of people who have been incarcerated in prisons or jails back into the community.

The Norfolk Prisoner Reentry T.E.A.M. consists of numerous professional staff who assist people with securing needed resources to aid in their **T**ransition.

The T.E.A.M. goal is to empower people to **E**ngage in pro-social activities to help them **A**chieve independence.
