This project will stabilize 2522 linear feet of shoreline behind the Barraud Park and Lindenwood communities. The improvement is intended to prevent loss of private property, establish habitat for native wildlife and enhance the visual aesthetic of the community.

Restore approximately 1.68 acres of wetland marsh.
