SCOPE OF WORK

- Install new water lines
- Install new sanitary sewer
- Install new storm water structures
- Rebuild streets with new sidewalks, curbs, gutters and aprons

\$4,300,000

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS/TRAFFIC

- Work will be performed Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM There will be alternating lane closures and intermittent traffic stoppages. Motorists are encouraged to take alternate routes to avoid construction.
