



## Chesapeake Blvd and Cromwell Drive Intersection Improvements (UPC 108797)

### Location

Chesapeake Boulevard & Cromwell Drive

### Project Benefits

This project will improve safety of the intersection by providing a new traffic signal with flashing yellow arrow signal heads.

### Scope of Work

- New traffic signal poles and mast arms
- Retroreflective backplates and flashing yellow arrow signals
- Upgraded pedestrian accommodations
- Removal of slip lane on southwest corner of intersection
- Stormwater improvements

- Anticipated construction start: Winter 2021
- Anticipated construction completion: Fall 2021

### Project Funding

Highway Safety Improvement Program (100% Federal/State, 0% Local)

### Construction Impacts

- Lane closures and sidewalk closures will be required; at least one lane in each direction will be open at all times.
- Installation of the new signal poles and mast arms may require small detour
