## Career Training Opportunities

Must meet eligibility in one of these boxes;

Reside in Norfolk, Receiving SNAP benefits and meet at least 1 criteria below;

- Misdemeanor or felony convictions
- 18-49 years old with no dependents on SNAP case or exemptions (ABAWDS)
- Child Support case with TANF debt owed
- Youth/Young Adult transitioning from Foster Care (17-27 yrs. old)

Reside in Norfolk and meet both of the criteria's listed below;

- Low to Moderate Income
- Employment impacted by COVID-19 by either furlough, termination, reduced hours, layoff, etc.

### Gateway Academy

All participants must first complete assigned activities during a 4 week period while enrolled into NDHS services. Activities may include but are not limited to; job readiness classes and professional development workshops, etc.

\*Activities are held Mon-Fri during business hours.

Upon completion of all Gateway Academy activities, participants will be eligible for funding with local training providers.

Must have ability to participate in services virtually by phone, email and have access to a computer and internet service.

- Commercial Driver's License – Class A (Must have a valid driver's license)
- CompTIA A+\*
- Medical Billing & Coding \*
