



Citywide Pedestrian Improvements (UPC 112759)

Location

Military Highway between Johnston's Road and Longdale Drive and includes pedestrian improvements at the associated intersections.

Project Benefits

This project will provide safer pedestrian travel and access to public transportation along the project corridor.

Scope of Work

- Tree removal (76 trees) and tree plantings (76 trees) along west side of N. Military Hwy.
- New sidewalk along the west side of N. Military Hwy from Johnston Rd connecting to the existing sidewalk.
- Install new crosswalks with countdown pedestrian signals and ADA Ramps

- Anticipated completion: Summer 2026

Construction Impacts

- Significant tree removal is required.
- Temporary lane closures will be required.
